Mighty men

When I was 4 or 5 years old, if I had been asked to sum up, in one word, what I wanted to be when I grew up, I'd have probably come up with "mighty."

Having been raised on the King James Bible, I had heard that word a lot in Sunday school. Genesis, where kids' classes spent a good deal of time, refers to "mighty men which were of old, men of renown," (Genesis 6:4) and Nimrod, the "mighty hunter before the Lord." (Genesis 10:8). There were mighty winds, mighty waters, mighty princes, mighty thundering and hail -- and above all, God's mighty hand.

On top of that, there was my favorite cartoon hero, Mighty Mouse. He flew with a cape like Superman, sang like an opera star, and rescued poor mice damsels who were constantly being picked on by evil cats. I doubted I would ever be super, but I had high hopes for mighty.

For one thing, my dad was mighty, and I was determined to be like him.

I don't remember my dad ever being called upon to do anything heroic -- not in the classic sense of the word. I never saw him dash into a burning building and rescue anyone, lift a car off of a wreck victim or beat up a bad guy. He didn't fly or sing opera, and he wouldn't have been caught dead in a cape. But he was strong and kind, smart and funny. He worked hard and provided for his family, served his community and his church. He was a loving husband to my mom, a loyal friend, a good boss, a natural leader.

He was, in short, a dad. Maybe that's the definition of mighty.

Call it everyday mighty. It's what dads do. It's not flashy, but don't sell it short.
